
THE POST OFFICES OF SOULANGES COUNTY

Soulanges County, established in 1855, is a rather irregular tongue of land situated on the north shore of the St. Lawrence west of the Island of Montreal (or more precisely, of Ile Perrot), and extends from Pointe-des-Cascades to the Ontario border. It is derived from the seigniories of Soulanges and Nouvelle Longueuil; the former was granted to Pierre-Jacques Joybert de Soulanges on October 12, 1702, and the latter to Joseph Lemoyne, the Seigneur of Longueuil, on April 21, 1734. The first inhabitants of Canada, well before the arrival of the French, must certainly have trod the soil of a part of this territory in order to avoid the rapids between Lake St. Louis and Lake St. François - likely between Pointe-desCascades and Coteau Landing.

From the point of view of the mails, the municipal county of Soulanges has had twenty-one post offices. Today only eleven remain, the others having been gradually eliminated because of Rural Mail Delivery. The alphabetical list given here shows the opening date, the closing date of those offices no longer current, as well as other names these offices may have operated under. Note in passing that of the twentyone offices listed, twelve were open prior to Confederation; there is no question of this being a "new territory". In the case of a name change, the date listed under "Opening Date" or "Closing Date" is the date of the name change. Also listed are the Money Order Office Number (MOON) and the Post Office Computer Organization Number (POCON) of the offices to which these were assigned.
