With approximately 1,000,000 items, the philatelic collections are composed of postage stamps and related materials, including all aspects of original stamp design up to final production; postal stationery; selected postally used covers; cancellation proofs; philatelic labels and revenue stamps.

There are also a number of related archival collections in various media (e.g. photographs, manuscripts and papers, maps, broadsides, circulars, posters, etc.) which document the history of the postal service and the hobby of stamp collecting in Canada.

Finally, a comprehensive philatelic library helps researchers to better understand the many facets of Canadian and world-wide philately and postal history.

BIOGRAPHY/ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

The British North America Philatelic Society, Ltd., **BNAPS**, is a philatelic specialist group for collectors and researchers of the stamps, postal markings, and postal history of Canada, the pre-Confederation colonies, and Newfoundland.

BNAPS was founded in 1943 by Mr. Jack Levine who assembled a group of other philatelists who shared his interests in the postage stamps and postal history of British North America. The constitution and by-laws were approved at the first regular meeting that year. The society journal BNA Topics was launched in 1944, the Sales Department was started the same year, the Society established a Library in 1945, and published its first Yearbook in 1946, and held its first convention and exhibition in 1949.

The society became The British North America Philatelic Society Ltd. in 1987, a tax-exempt corporation, accompanied by a move of its registered office to Wisconsin and new By-laws. In 1993, the Society established a Speakers Bureau to provide speakers for organized philatelic shows or other meetings scheduled by **BNAPS**, and an Ambassadorship Program to staff Society tables at these shows. The same year, the **BNAPS** Library was dispersed, with many items going to the Canadian Postal Archives library and the American Philatelic Research Library, and other items auctioned off. **BNAPS** has grown to publish both a journal and a newsletter (BNAPortraitS); and include numerous departments; committees; regional groups; and specialized study groups, the latter with their own elected officials and newsletters. Sometimes these newsletters are developed into specialized handbooks produced by the **BNAPS** Handbook Committee. There are also philatelic exchange circuits for members to dispose of unwanted BNA material and add new items to their collections, each circuit with its own manager.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Fonds consists of George A.E. Chapman's manuscript, 1940-1951, predominant 1950-1951, on the Canadian cents issue of 1859, for articles published in BNA Topics during the late Nineteen Fifties and early Nineteen Sixties.

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BIOGRAPHY/ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

Ken Barlow was born October 1 in Liverpool, England, and educated in Penrith, Cumberland. He served with the RAF for 3 years, graduating as a pilot and commissioned officer. He later graduated from Liverpool University in 1948 with a B.Eng. in civil engineering and was later granted an M.Eng.

Mr. Barlow emigrated to Vancouver late in 1948, married in 1949, and raised 4 sons. He worked mostly in industrial engineering, retiring in 1987.

Ken Barlow's philatelic interests are quite broad. He is very interested and active in the field of postal history, generally Canadian and several specialities in Great Britain. He has been a member of the British North America Philatelic Society (**BNAPS**), the Canadian Philatelic Society of Great Britain (CPSGB), and several local clubs. He has written numerous articles on postal history.

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BIOGRAPHY/ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

Julian C. Smith, professor, was born in Montreal, but became a citizen of the United States, where he has made his career. He studied Chemical Engineering at Cornell University where he would become a professor, and in 1975, Director of the School of Chemical Engineering. He worked abroad as visiting professor at least twice, consulted for a number of large corporations, published extensively in his field and belongs to the major chemical associations.

A philatelist since childhood, Smith's mentors in this area were Bill Maresch, James N. Sissons and H. P. William. His strength as a collector is in unused Canada, of which he had an impressive collection. Much of his collection was previously in other famous collections, and therefore of excellent provenance. He has won many awards, including the Grand at BNAPS 1981. He has written on several philatelic subjects, including methods to detect forgeries.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Collection consists of Province of Canada/Canada unused postage stamps including 3 Pence "Beaver" (1851); 1/2 Penny "Queen Victoria" (1857); 10 cents "Albert, Prince Consort" (1859); 3 and 15 cents large "Queen Victoria" (1868); 1 cent **small "Queen Victoria"** (1872).

This search engine provides documentary information on nearly 2,300 stamps released by Canada and British North America and approximately 35,000 individual descriptions of documents. It also allows on-line consultation of more than 5,000 digitized documents. The number of these documents is expected to increase regularly.

Descriptions are generally written in the language of the creator or donor, and English largely predominates.







Herman Herbert Schwartz , 1885-1962

Occupation: Designer

Biographical Sketch:

Herman Herbert Schwartz, designer, was born in Nova Scotia on May 13, 1885, of Dutch ancestry. He showed little interest in the family spice business, W.H. Schwartz & Sons, founded by his grandfather in Halifax in 1841. He was interested in art. In August 1909, he was hired as an apprentice by the American Bank Note Company (ABNC) of Ottawa. Schwartz was transferred to ABNC headquarters in New York City in 1917 to acquire more experience and to continue his studies. While there, between 1917 and 1920, he worked at the office during the day and attended classes at the National Academy of Design in the evening.

He is credited with the design of 144 Canadian stamps issued between 1927 and 1956. He designed the famous Bluenose stamp issued in 1929. He also designed foreign postage stamps and Canadian bank notes. He retired in 1956 at 70 after a career of 47 years. Schwartz died in Ottawa on March 22, 1962.

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



This collection includes a variety of documents such as monographs, specialized catalogues, brochures and series on philately, as well as numerous works about the history of Canadian and international postal services. This research tool is essentially a catalogue of the [philatelic library](#). It can be used to conduct searches of the 6 500 catalogued titles, including monographs and specialized catalogues. It should be noted that periodicals and auction catalogues are not yet part of this database.



The collection includes most of the philatelic periodicals published in Canada and a wide range of publications from all over the world. One will find serials, older and current publications, those published by the Post Office Department and Canada Post, local bulletins of stamp clubs as well those published by national and international philatelic societies.

The listing, organized by title of the periodicals, represents an exhaustive inventory of the holdings, titles' changes if applicable and identifies, where appropriate, the organization behind its publication. Most of the publications are also catalogued in the Canadian National Catalogue Amicus and the Philatelic Library Database.

It is possible to borrow these publications from the Interlibrary loans.

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

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

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
